Day 1 Depart USA

Depart the USA on your overnight flight to Dubrovnik, Croatia.

Day 2 Dubrovnik, Croatia

Welcome to Croatia. Upon arrival, you'll be met at the airport and transferred to the hotel on the group transfer. The remainder of the day is at leisure.

Day 3 Dubrovnik

Day 4 Dubrovnik

The sixth-largest island in the Adriatic, Korčula is among the most beloved in Croatia. Its Old Town, referred to by the locals as "Little Dubrovnik", is a delightful collection of medieval churches, palaces and squares, while the villages of Čara and Smokvica produce the country's signature dry white wine. **Meals: B, L, D**

Day 6 Split

Enjoy a taste of real Dalmatian life in awe-inspiring Split. Croatia's second-largest city effortlessly brings together the country's traditional and contemporary elements. Day 7 Hvar
